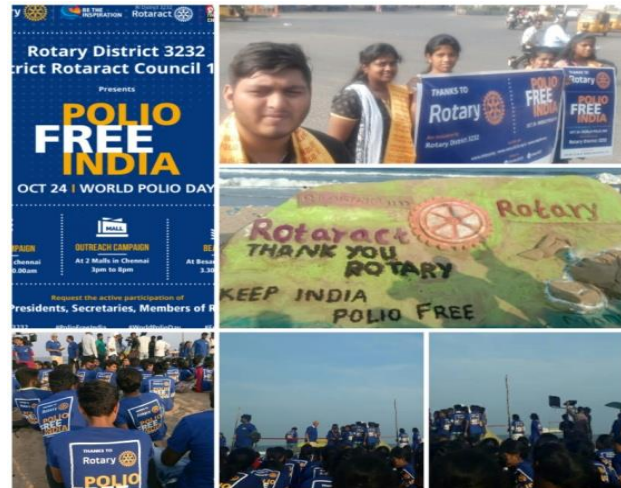
SUPPORTED ROTARY EVENTS
